THE RESERVE BANK OF INDIA TODAY APPEALED TO MEMBERSOF PUBLIC NOT TO USE BANK NOTES FOR MAKING GARLANDS, DECORATING PANDALS AND PLACES OF WORSHIP OR FORSHOWERING ON PERSONALITIES IN SOCIAL EVENTS ETC., SUCHACTIONS DEFACE THE BANKNOTES AND SHORTEN THEIR LIFE, THE RESERVE BANK STATED AND ADDED THAT BANKNOTESSHOULD BE RESPECTED AS THEY ARE A SYMBOL OF THESOVEREIGN AND PUBLIC SHOULD NOT MISUSE THEM AND HELPIN INCREASING THE LIFE OF BANKNOTES. THE RESERVE BANKHAS ALSO STATED THAT IT HAS BEEN TAKING ALL MEASURESTO SUPPLY CLEAN BANKNOTES ACROSS THE COUNTRY ANDHAS URGED THE MEMBERS OF PUBLIC TO CONTRIBUTE THEIRMITE TO ITS EFFORTS IN PURSUING A 'CLEAN NOTE POLICY' FORTHE COUNTRY.
